

## Behaviour Management Plan

We believe that there are rights and responsibilities involved in being part of Takapuna Normal Intermediate School. Most importantly all have the right to feel safe, the right to learn and teach and the right to be treated with respect and dignity. Any breach of this belief will involve the school wide Behaviour Management Plan. We have high expectations of learning and behaviour. The school rules are:

1. All school members will behave in a way that demonstrates courtesy, consideration and respect for self, others and school property.

This means no:

Put downs – verbal intimidation  
Unwanted touching  
Notes  
Deliberate exclusion  
Swearing  
Answering back  
Obscene gestures in public/bus  
Internet intimidation

Physical intimidation  
Unwanted telephone calls/text messages  
Threats  
Damaging property of others/school  
Disobedience insolence  
Spreading rumours  
Name calling

2. All students to be in the correct place at the correct time

This means:

Stay out of 'out of bounds' areas e.g. carparks, Smiths Bush, behind Science, Room 4, Rooms 5, Science and Caretaker's Shed  
Must have Teachers' permission to leave the room  
Stay out of specific staff only areas – Staffroom, Resource Room, Teachers' Workroom.

3. No banned or prohibited items are permitted at school

This means no:

Skateboards  
Gum  
Fizzy Drink  
Aerosol deodorants  
Dog chains (collars), Fob chains

Scooters  
Excessive hair solutions e.g. spiked hair  
Lollies  
Laser Pointers  
Jewellery, piercing

Martial arts weapons	Inappropriate hair ornaments
Cigarettes, matches, lighters	Drugs (including panadol)
CD/cassette walkmans/ipods	Electronic games
Medication without notification	Cellphones
Materials (magazines, etc.) that would cause offence	
Weapons of any kind (including guns & pocket knives)	

4. The school uniform is always to be worn correctly

This means :

Appropriate items worn in correct fashion/manner

Plain watch

No jewellery - rings/neck chains etc.

One pair of stud earrings i.e. 1 small plain stud per ear (3mm)

Socks pulled up (boys) blue socks (girls)

Trousers pulled up

Hair tied back (shoulder length or longer) with plain clips (male and female). Hair bands must not be wider than 2cm.

Hair ties must be dark blue or black

Black sandals worn in summer correctly

Black leather lace up shoes in winter (max 2 cm heel). – no skate or sport type shoes

No nail polish – remover held in office

Uniform kept in good repair (holes/rips/buttons missing mended)

Jumpers not tied around waists

Long sleeves at wrist level, not hanging down around fingers or beyond

Complete uniform to be worn to/from school i.e. not PE/or parts of.

School hat to be worn Term 1 and Term 4 (no exceptions)

No alternative hair styles or excessive use of gel.

### **Compulsory Observance**

1. Wearing correct school uniform. Unless prior written permission has been obtained, non-uniform items will be impounded and parents/guardians asked to collect them.
2. Safety helmets and Fluoro Vests for cyclists.

NB : No concessions are made for students living beyond the zone and this includes early release from school to catch public transport.
